The Mauritius Ports Authority (MPA) is pleased to invite sealed bids both from local and International bidders for the Design, Supply, Installation and Commissioning of Centralised Access Control and CCTV Systems for Port Area Surveillance as more fully described in the bidding document.

Description of Project

The MPA intends to implement a modern CCTV system fully integrated with a port wide Access Control System with a view to strengthen security measures in the port area.

The Scope of the project includes inter alia the following:

- Design, Supply, Install and commission a port wide centralized Access Control System;
- Design, Supply, Install and commission a new CCTV System;
- Design, Supply, Install and commission a Networking System using both fibre and wireless to support the above systems; and
- Maintenance on the system.

Qualification requirements

- The contractor shall demonstrate having experience as prime contractor in the implementation of at least one project including an integrated CCTV and Centralized Access control system over the last 5 years.
- Other qualifying criteria mentioned in the bid document.

Submission of bids

One original and 2 copies of the bid (in hard copies only) must be submitted in accordance with the Instruction to Bidders in sealed envelopes clearly marked "**CPB Reference: CPB/64/2019-Supply, Installation and Commissioning of Centralised Access Control and CCTV Systems for Port Area Surveillance**" which shall be addressed to the **Chief Executive, Central Procurement Board, 1st Floor, Social Security Office, Julius Nyerere Avenue, Rose Hill, Republic of Mauritius.**

Bid Security

Bids shall be accompanied by a Bid Security in the amount of **MUR 1,000,000 or USD 27,800 or EURO 25,700 or GBP 21,810.** The bid security shall be in the form of an unconditional bank guarantee issued by a recognized commercial bank in Mauritius or a foreign bank through a correspondent bank located in Mauritius. Bids without a Bid Security will be rejected.

Deadline for the submission of bids

Bids should be either deposited in the **Bid box** located in the **Central Procurement Board, 1st Floor, Social Security Office, Julius Nyerere Avenue, Rose Hill, Republic of Mauritius** or submitted by registered post/courier so as to reach the **Central Procurement Board** on or before **Tuesday 11 February 2020 up to 13.30 hrs. (local time) at latest.**

Bids will be opened in the **Conference Room of the Central Procurement Board** on the same day at **14.00 hrs (local time)** in the presence of bidders or their representatives who choose to attend.

Bids received after the specified closing date and time will not be considered.
